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MENTORING POLICY

Mentoring aims to provide mentees with a network of support throughout the academic session in their intellectual, professional, and academic growth. The mentoring helps students to develop life skills through value-based education and community service programmes.

- Mentors will be assigned students from the same department as mentees.
- The mentee assigned to a mentor at the beginning of a program will continue with the same mentor till the end of the program.
- Apart from department mentors, PwD students will be allotted faculty mentors (Nodal Officer) who will look after their special needs.

The mentors must

- meet their mentees on a regular basis, at least once a month and do the follow up.
- maintain a record of mentoring and be kept confidential.
- guide the mentee and encourage them to make decisions and set objectives according to their development.
- update them on various scholarships, fellowships, competitions, internships, research projects, job opportunities, etc.
- counsel academically backward students and help them to improve in academics.
- take effort to organize special/remedial classes for slow learners in the group.
- take efforts to motivate mentees, build their self-assurance, stimulate their creativity, recognize their contributions, and navigate their path toward independence.

Mentees must

- Attend the mentor-mentee sessions promptly.
- Cooperate with the mentor in the Mentoring programme to ensure one's growth.




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
