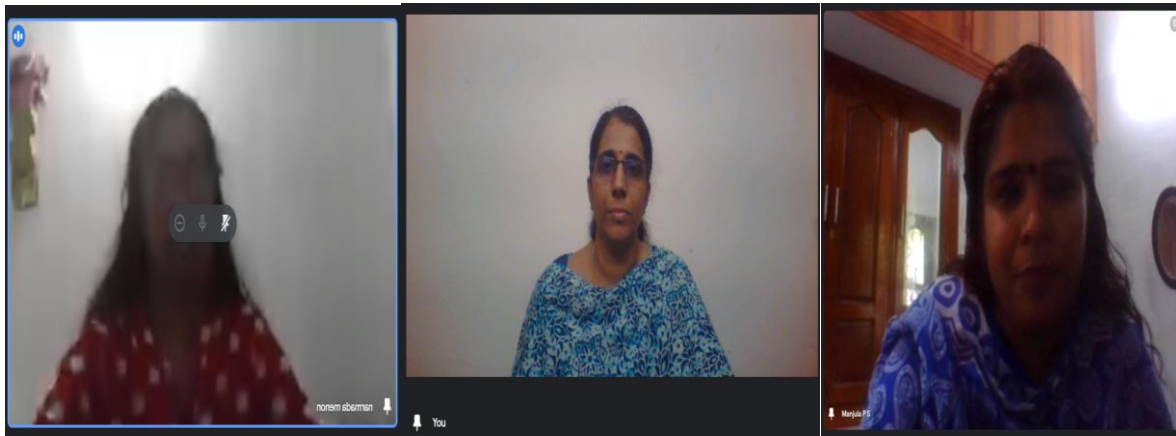
6. Peer teaching

N.S.S. College, Ottapalam, affiliated to the University of Calicut was founded in 1961 by the great visionary and social reformer, Bharata Kesari Sri. Mannath Padmanabhan. The college was consecrated by Swami Vishadanandha, President of Shri. Ramakrishna Ashram, Palappuram and was formally inaugurated by Mrs. Prabhakaran Thampan. Presently the college has 13 UG courses and 6 PG courses. College is accredited by NAAC with A grade in the year 2017.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The UG B.Sc. Chemistry was started in the year 1963. In 2001, department introduced a UGC sponsored degree course in Industrial Chemistry. These courses have a sanctioned strength of 28 and 25 respectively. Both the programs include courses in Organic, Physical and Inorganic chemistry as core subjects and Mathematics and Computer science as complementary subjects. The industrial chemistry program includes additional courses of Entrepreneurship, Informatics, Health and Nutrition and Medicinal chemistry. 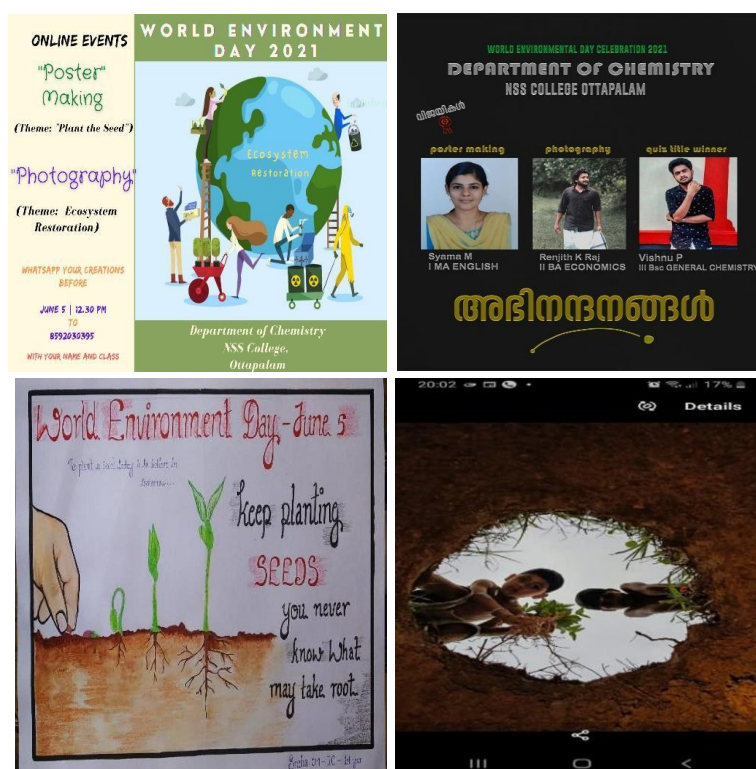
ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT

1. WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (5th June 2021)

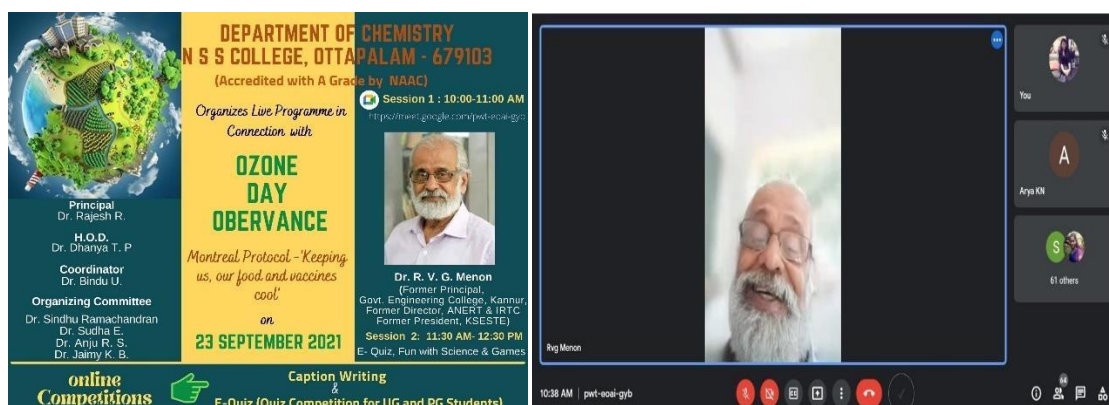

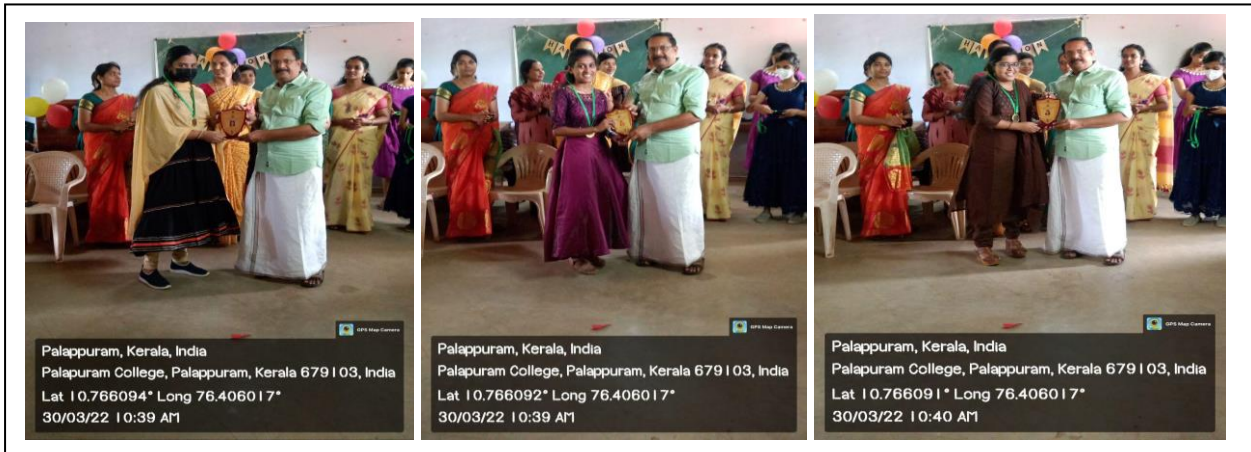
14. Tour Programme -Munnar to Vagamon

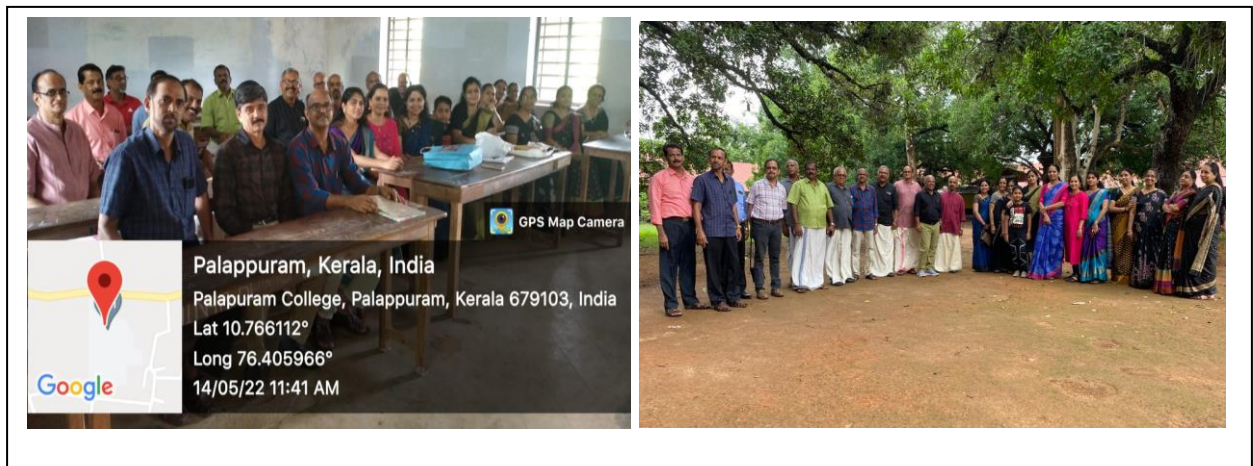
15. Merit Fest
