

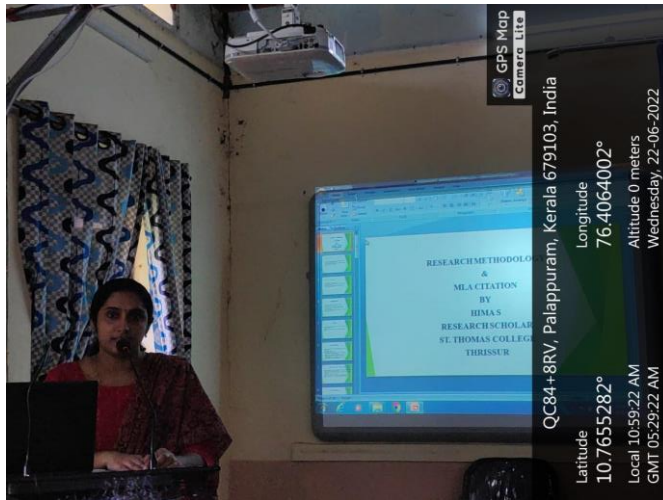

1. Seminar on Official language and Technical Terminology in Official Correspondence

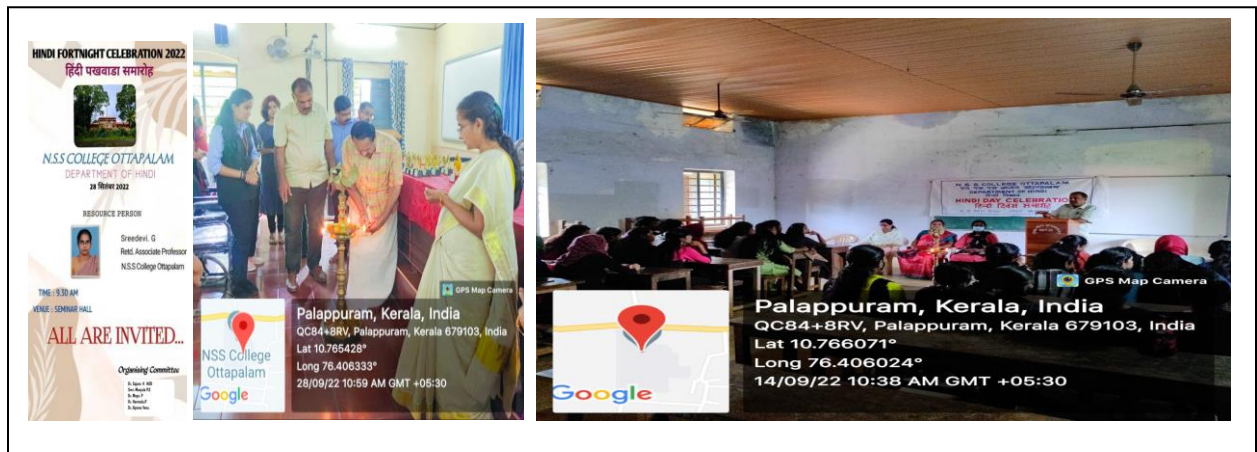

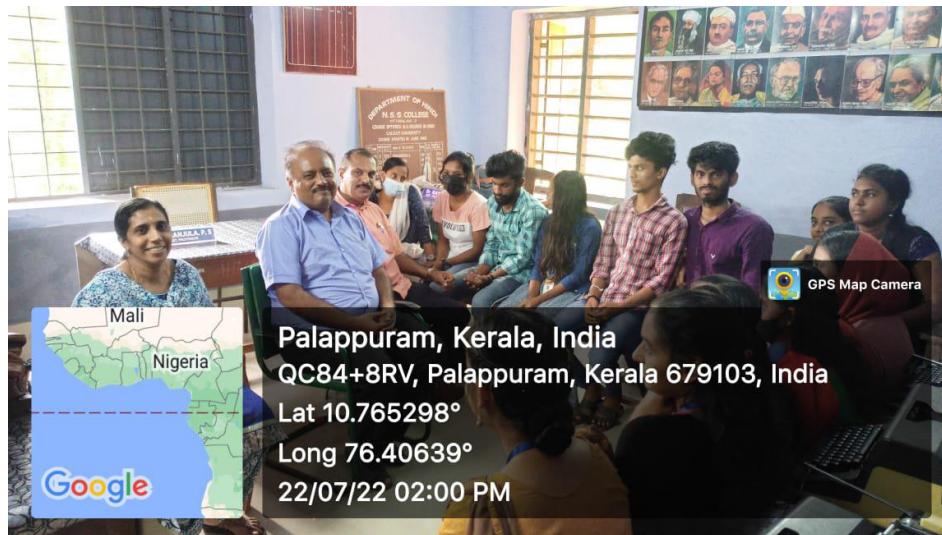

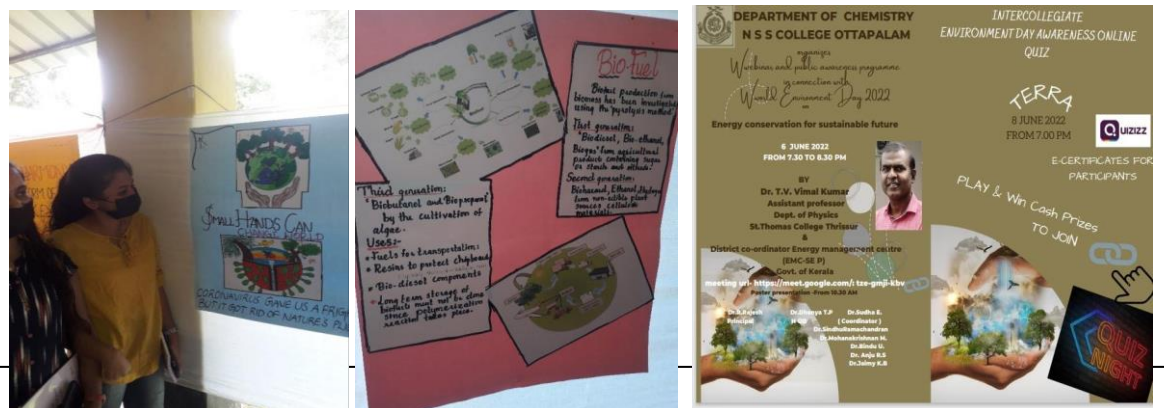
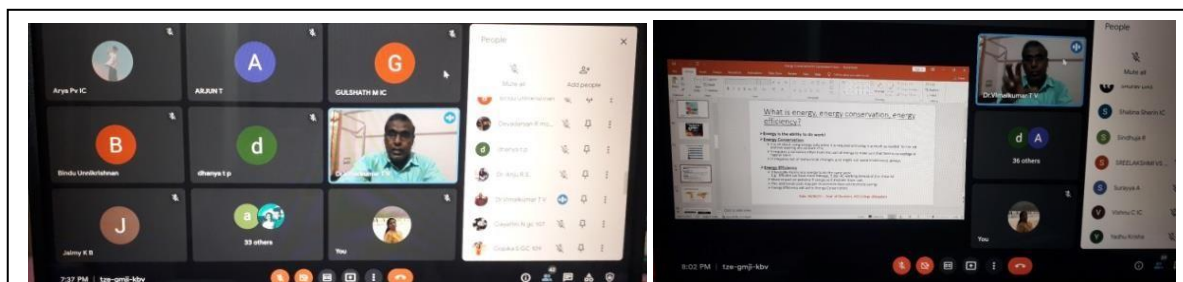
ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT

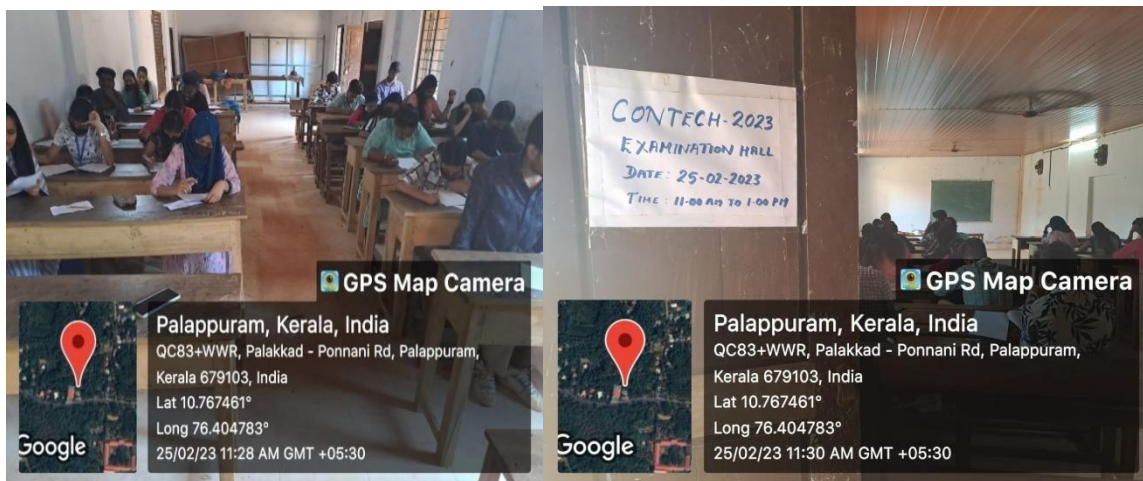

5. CONTECH (CONCEPT TEST IN CHEMISTRY) EXAMINATION (25th FEBRUARY 2023)

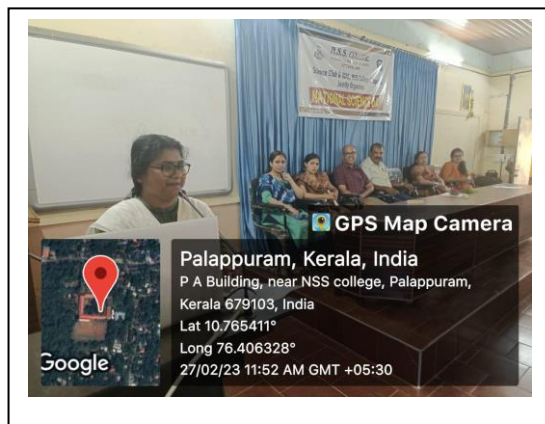

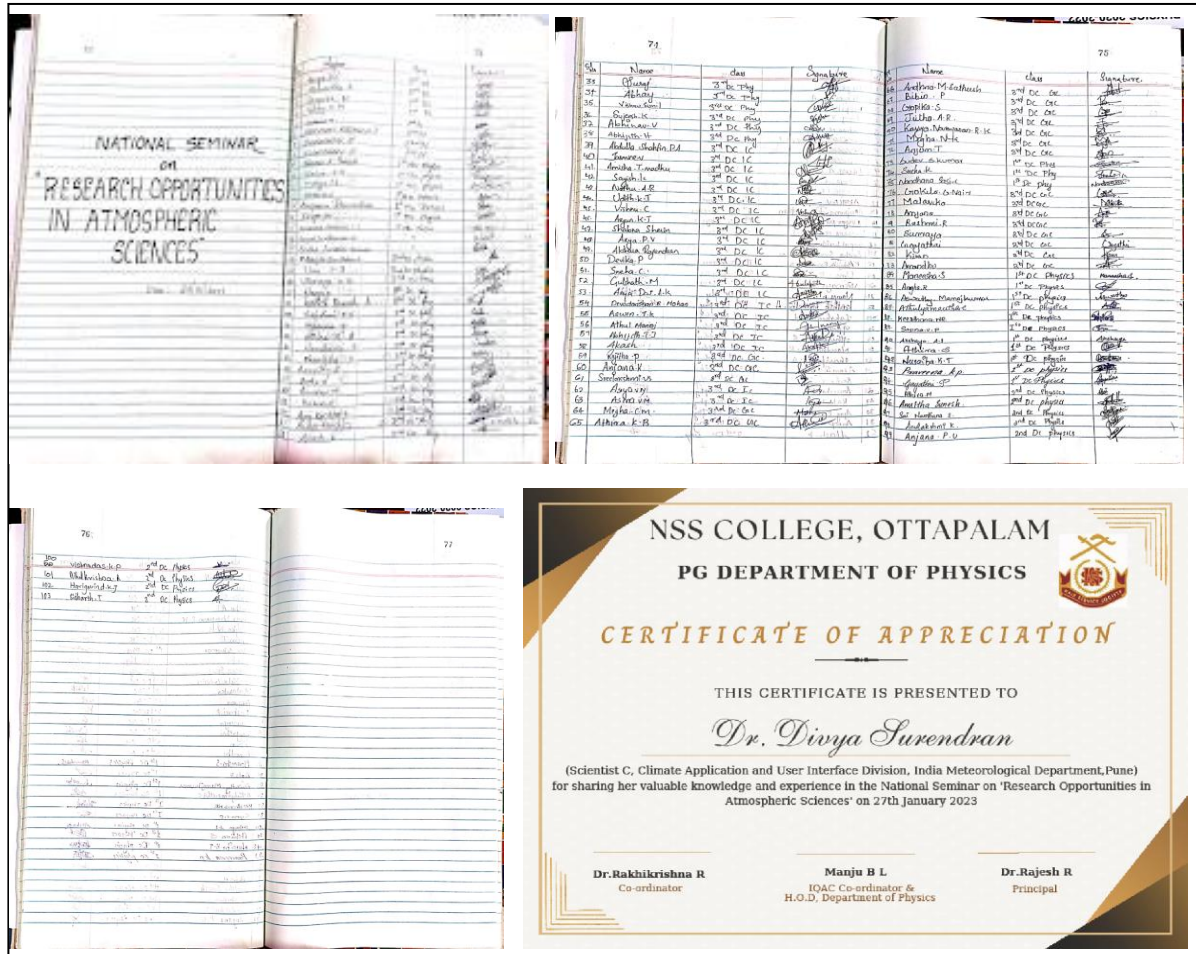

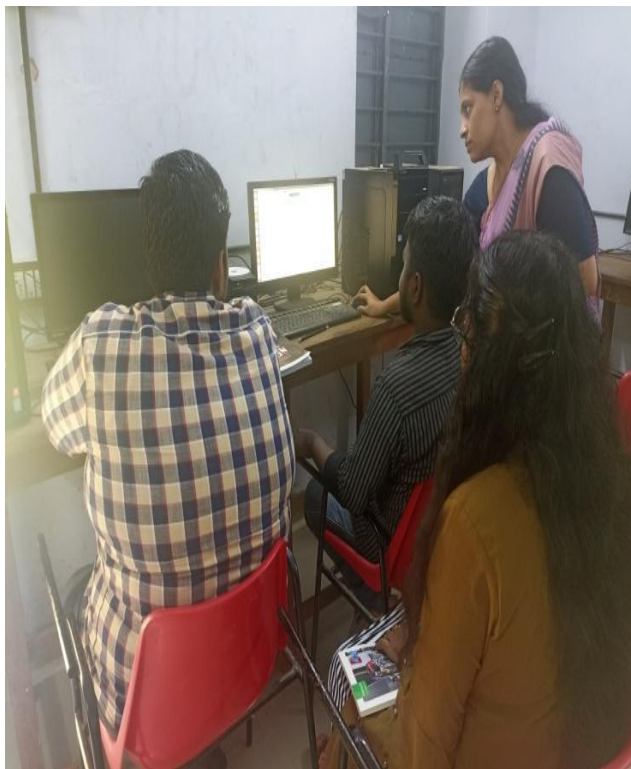


2. Bridge Course 2022-2023

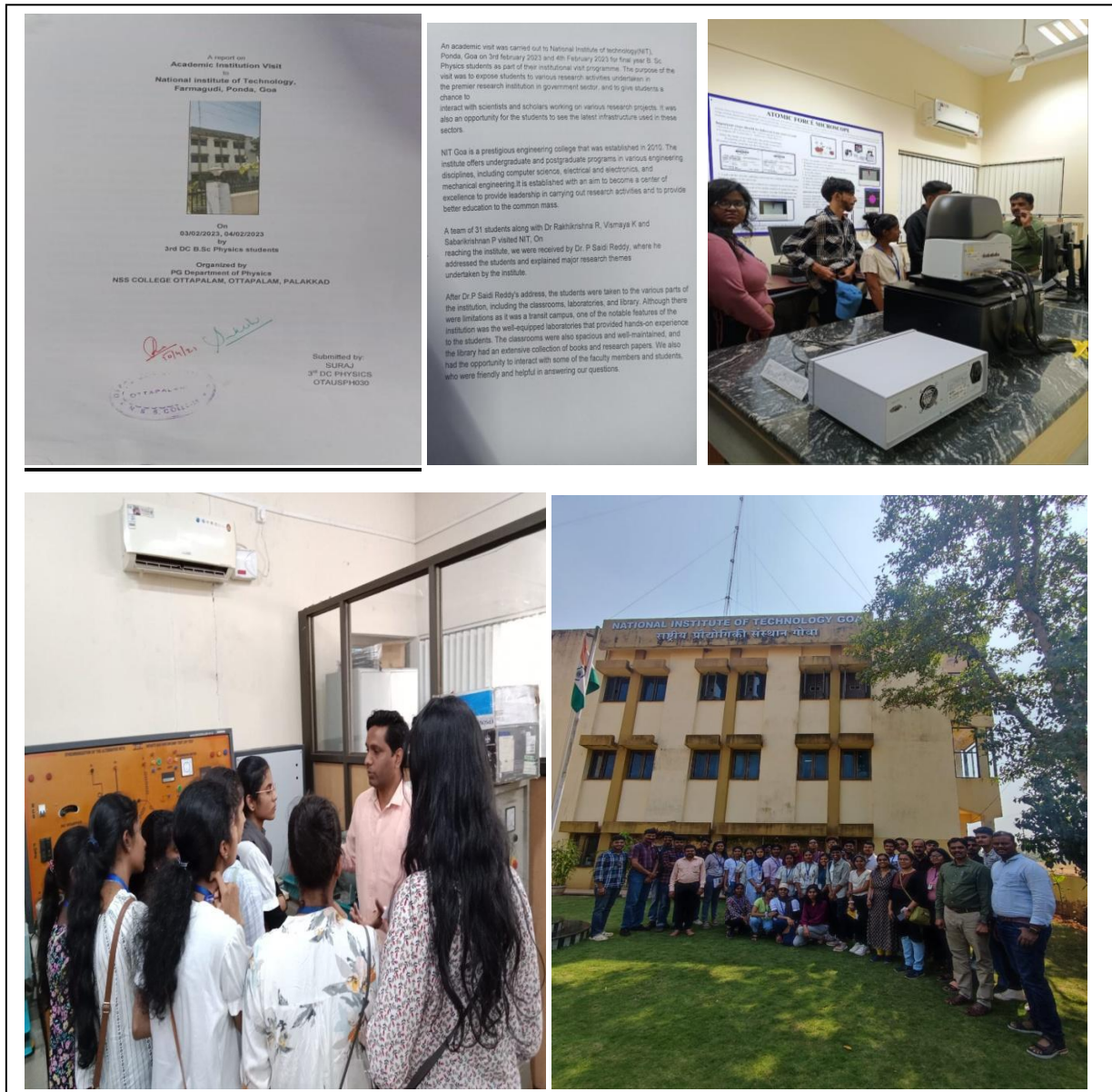

5. Physics Club Activity- “Training Program on safety measures of Electricity”

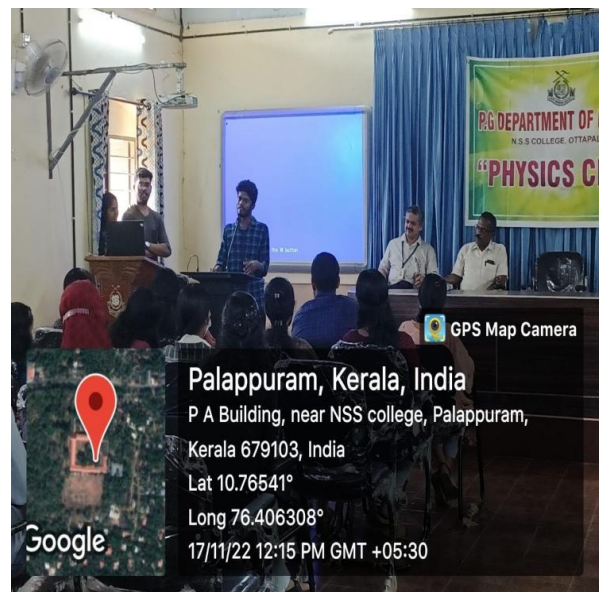
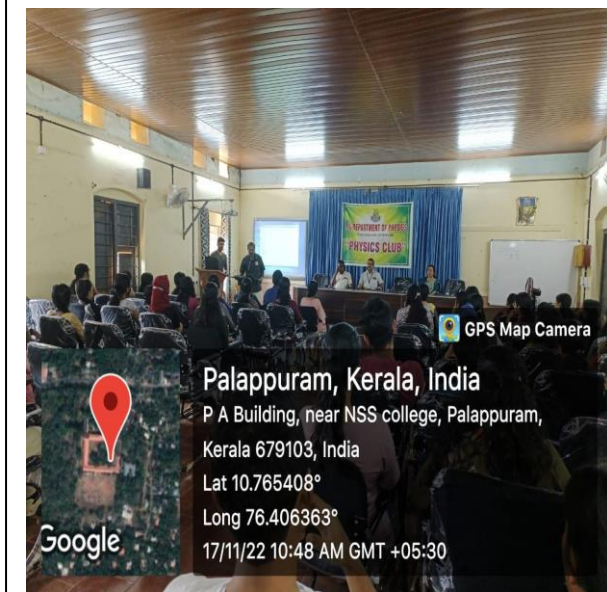

7. International Women’s Day and National Science Day Celebration-Students seminar

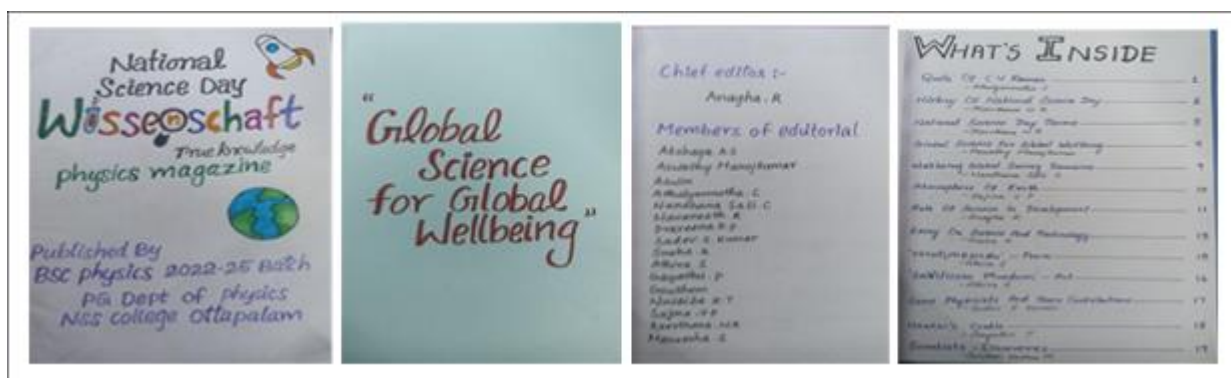

- (b) A PTS Meeting for VI Semester B.Sc. Zoology students was conducted in January 2023.

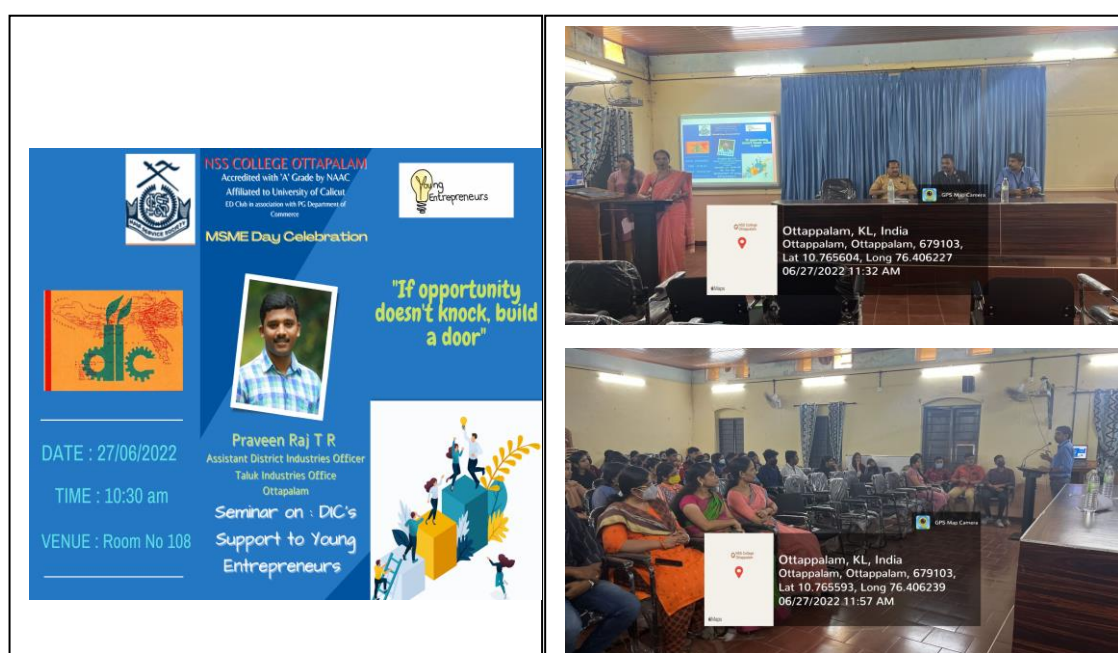
- (c) University Rank: Shahanas T. (OTATSZO025) secured 6th rank in the Calicut University B.Sc. Zoology degree Examination March 2022.

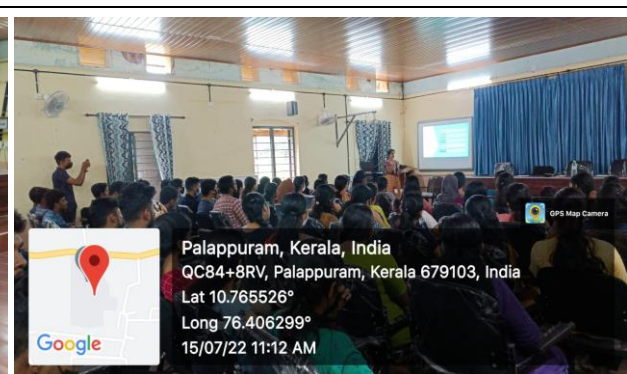

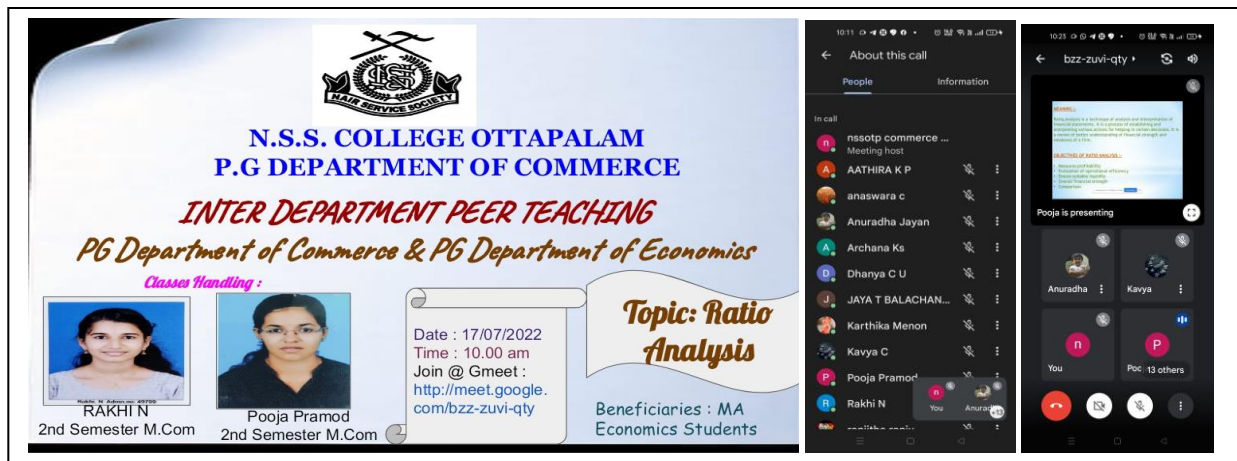

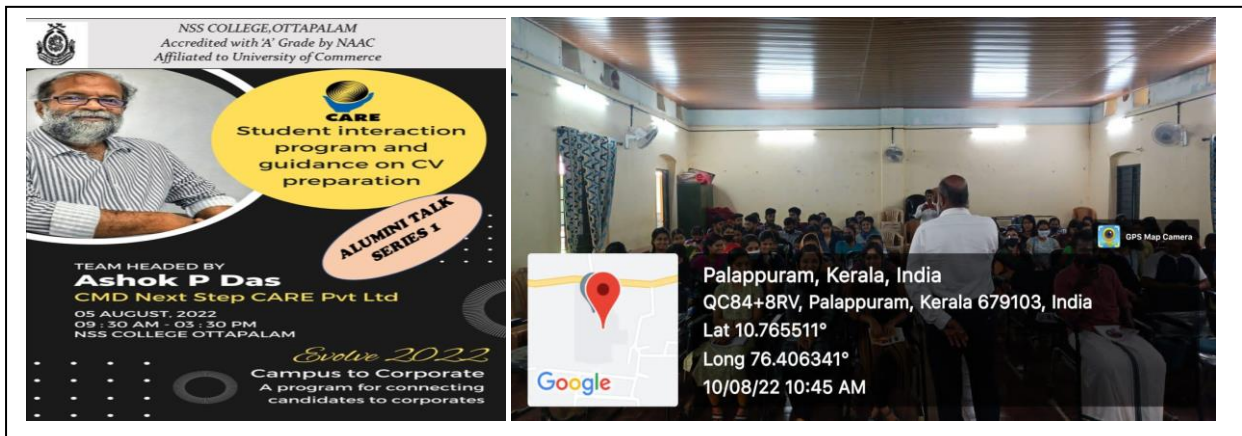


6. ENTREPRENEUR INSIGHT (26/07/2022)

Session 4

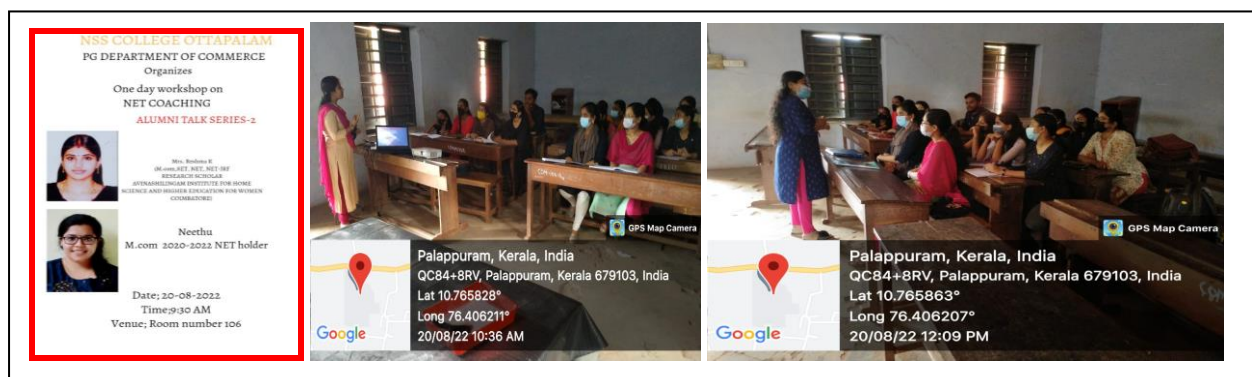

8. ALUMNI TALK SERIES - 2 NATIONAL LEVEL WORKSHOP ON NET COACHING

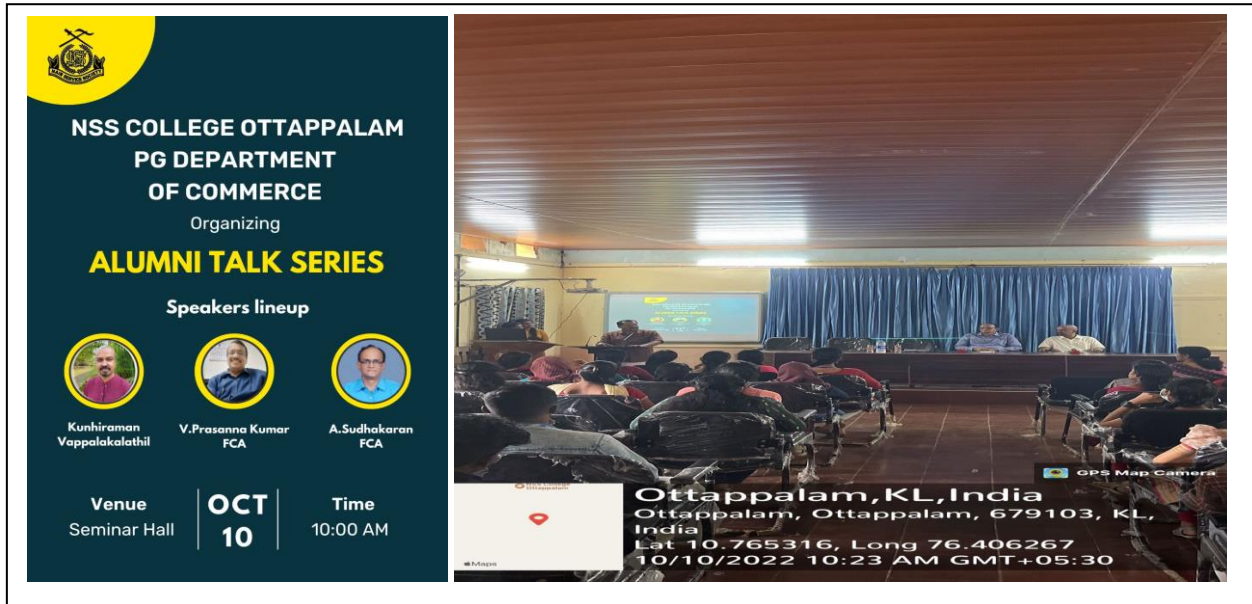
